DISTRICT SOLO & ENSEMBLE COMPETITION 2018

Lawrence North High School Band and Orchestra

- DATE:** Saturday, January 27, 2018
- WHERE:** Doe Creek Middle School, located at 5613 W 200 S., New Palestine, IN 46163, between US 40 and US 52.
- PARKING:** The best location to park will be on the South side of the building and enter through **door #9**. Additional parking is available at the "old" Doe Creek building located on the Southwest side of the school.
If there is a cancellation due to severe weather, an announcement will be made on WTHR Channel 13 on January 27.
- ARRIVAL:** Plan to arrive at least **30 minutes prior** to scheduled performance time. Solo and Ensemble performance schedules are affected by many variables. Students may not perform at the exact time as scheduled. **Please be patient.**
- MUSIC:** Students should provide music to the adjudicator. All of the performance measures must be numbered. Ensembles should have a group leader responsible for this activity. After their performance, students should retrieve the music that was used by the adjudicator and a voucher card indicating the rating received from the Door Monitor of the performance room.
- MEDALS:** The voucher card should be presented to the "Medal Table" at the performance site the day of performance to receive the appropriate award for performance.
- ETIQUETTE:** Do not interrupt a performance once it has begun. Door Monitors assist the performance room in avoiding interruptions. Please be respectful of these volunteer workers. Please remember to **turn off all cell phones and pagers** prior to entering the performance area. Performance rooms and hall areas should be kept as quiet and accessible as possible. Please assist in keeping the noise level to a minimum, especially outside of performance rooms.
- FOOD:** There will be food available at the performance site. Please be sure to keep all food and drink in the designated area and out of the warm-up and performance rooms.
- ADJUDICATOR SHEET:** This will only be made available to your Music Director or designated replacement at the end of the performance day.
- STATE:** A Gold Rating on Group I events is eligible to perform at the State Level. **Eligible students will be automatically entered, unless they have told their director they do not wish to participate** at state. The band or orchestra will pay for entry fees. If a student chooses to not participate after the entry fee has been paid, the student will be charged. State Solo & Ensemble is February 24, 2018.
- APPEARANCE:** Your appearance is important, DRESS TO IMPRESS!
- PERCUSSION EQUIPMENT:** Students are responsible for bringing their own mallets and any other percussion equipment needed. The following equipment will be provided: Concert Bass Drum, Timpani 23", 26", 29", 32", 4 1/3 Octave Marimba, Xylophone, Chimes.

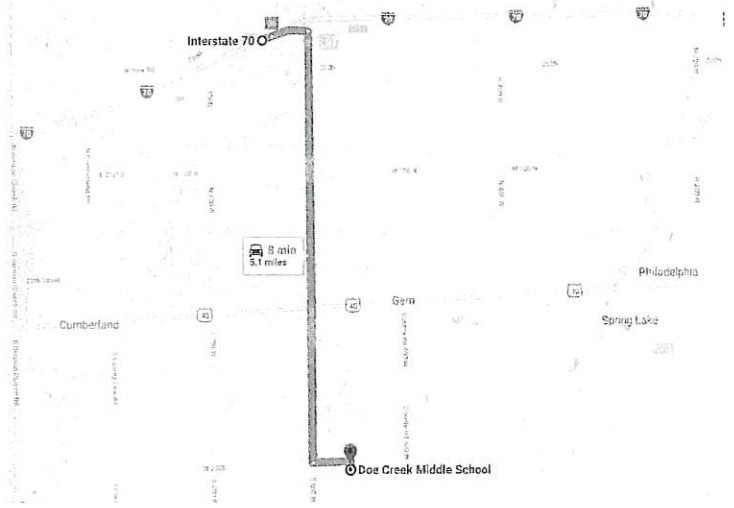
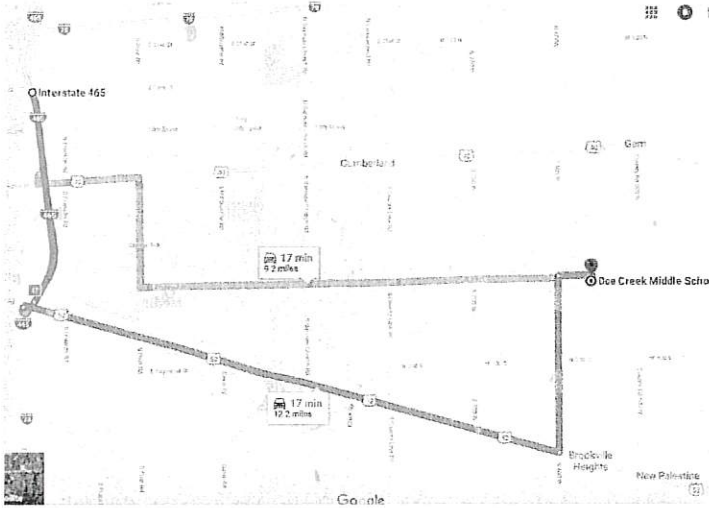

Driving Directions

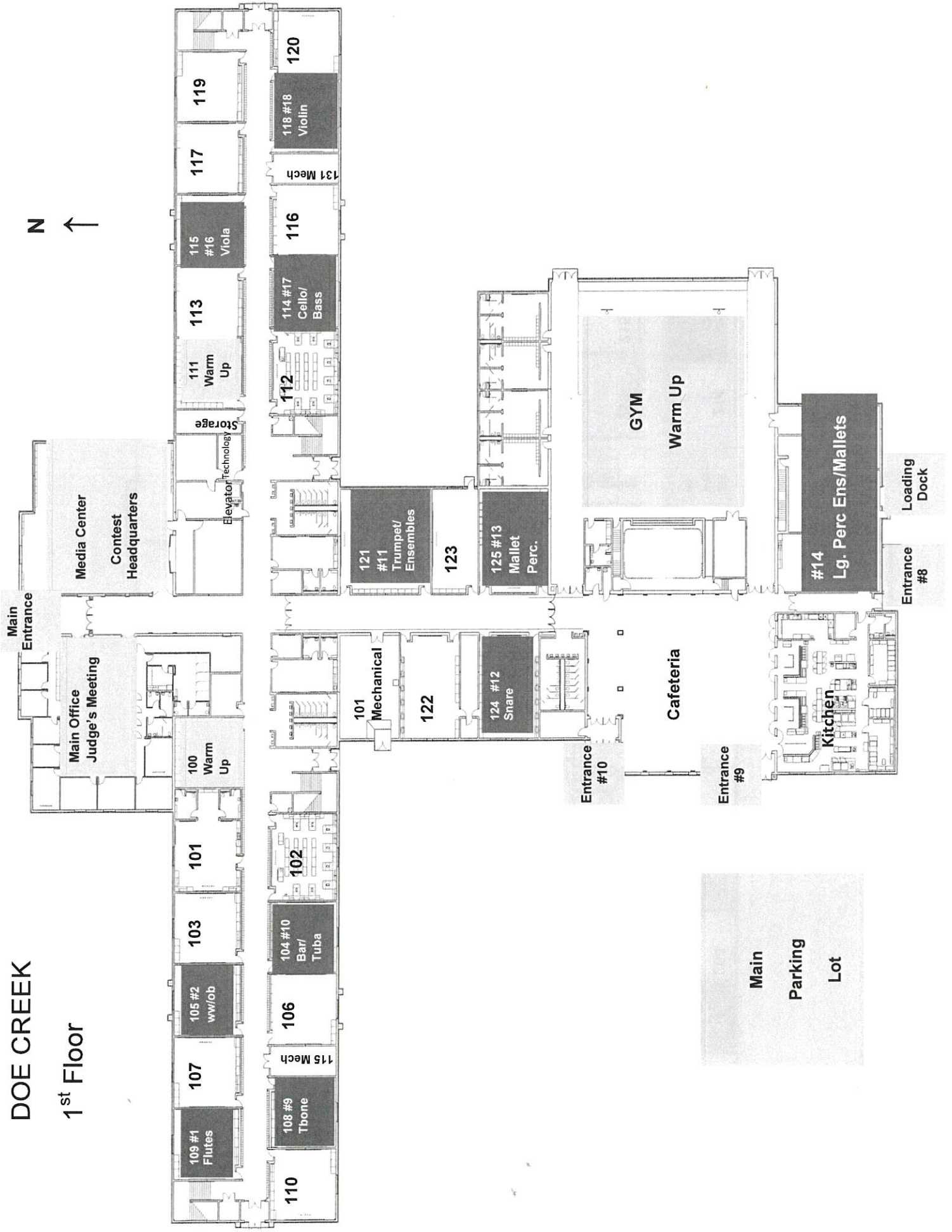
From I-70 East or West
