Director's Corner:

- We have heard from interested parents who want to help with the Orchestra Booster Club! The more people involved, the more we can do for the orchestras. Please email Mr. Valencia if you, too, can get involved.
- We have a list of <u>private lesson teachers</u> available on the web site. Some can visit the school. Others, you may choose to go to where they teach (their studio or their home). LNHS Orchestras highly encourages young musicians to explore private lessons so they can ultimately enjoy playing their instrument more and more.
- We also have private harp lessons available. This will be on a full-size harp with key-changing foot-pedals and will take place on Thursday mornings. Please sign up with Mr. Valencia and the teacher will start coming in.
- Lastly, I offer a message regarding practice habits for the young musicians. It is no secret that it is difficult to learn to play your instrument at a high level and that it can be frustrating along the way. One of the things that makes playing the instrument more fun is the ability to play well. That comes through practice.
 - What do teachers all over the world recommend? We recommend students practice a minimum of five days per week for a total of 2 ½ hours (30 minutes per session). It has been proven that the student who practices five days a week for 30 minutes each learns much more than a student who practices only 1 day a week for 2 ½ hours. Many smaller personal practice sessions are better than a single large one crammed in just before a test or performance.
 - What is the goal? Ultimately, the goal is to really enjoy playing your instrument.
 - How do you get there? By practicing enough to get good at the techniques required to do so.

Please connect with and encourage your student to practice. They need the reminder at this stage of their development.

- Some equipment that is very helpful for your student: orchestra music, a pencil, and a music stand so they don't have to lean over a table.

1. CONCERT ATTIRE
