Fundraiser – SNAP!

- We have kicked off a new fundraiser this year using the 'Snap!' program. It allows us to use email, social media, and text messaging to quickly raise money for our team. All that is asked of each participant is that they gather 20 or more email addresses of family, relatives & potential supporters that may be willing to donate to our cause. Your contacts are strictly private & protected: they will simply receive a personalized donation request on behalf of your student during our fundraiser.
- We really need full participation in order to reach our team goal. Many of our students still need to add 20 emails to their fundraising profiles. The organization has an incentive if we can get 70% of our students to participate, and there are individual incentives also.
- PARENT/GUARDIAN & STUDENT AT HOME INSTRUCTIONS: Students have already created an account on the Snap website with the help of his/her team leader and Snap Fundraising Coach.
 PLEASE DO NOT CREATE A SECOND ACCOUNT.
 - Ask your child to log into their account (check top of this page for their login credentials)
 - Ask your child to enter A MINIMUM OF 20 email addresses of their biggest fans
 - Follow the steps in the pop-up share wizard to share via Facebook & text message
