DIRECTOR'S CORNER:

- We have heard from interested parents who want to help with the Orchestra Booster Club! The more people involved, the more we can do for the orchestras. Please email Mr. Valencia if you, too, can get involved.
- Things the LN Orchestra Boosters can help with:
 - Raising money to help offset costs for the trip to see the Chicago Symphony Orchestra on April 14, 2017. The CSO consistently ranks as one of the best American Orchestras. We want this trip to be affordable and accessible to as many students as possible.
 - Raising money to help start the Mariachi program at LNHS that will bring together, string players, harpists, guitarists, trumpeters, and vocalists! This will be a multi-cultural experience worth having for the whole district.
 - Some special needs for the orchestra as we grow will be a need for more instruments in our inventory for young musicians who can't afford to rent from the local instrument stores.

- Harp lessons:

• We have the honor of having a real orchestra harp in our possession. A professional harp player who is a member of our township has volunteered to teach a select few students how to play the harp...for free! Someone needs to take advantage of this opportunity. Who is it going to be?

- Practice for orchestra:

A gentle reminder for students in orchestra. They are expected to practice at least 30 minutes, five times a week. This will lead to better playing and more fun playing. Also, personal practice time means the orchestra class gets to do what it supposed to do when it is together; musicians are supposed to learn how their parts fit together with other musicians' parts during a group rehearsal. That leads to excellence in music-making. And, I know your young musicians can do it!

- Concert experiences coming up:

- IN-American String Teachers Association Orchestra Invitational Festival will be held as a field trip on Friday, November 4. Chamber Orchestra will be performing for evaluation and a clinic. We will return prior to the end of G3.
- Veteran's Day Convocation: Chamber Orchestra is going to play with the band and chorus.
 Date and time is still undetermined so, please ask your student about notice for this event.
 It will be held during the school day.
- Our next concert for ALL orchestras will be December 7 at 7 pm at the LNHS Auditorium.
 Help make sure your student is practicing their part of the music so that we can work on making the music more in tune with the other parts.
 - Extra rehearsals for the Chamber orchestra are: Monday evenings, 6 8 pm, November 14, November 28, and December 5.
