## Expectations for class.

Please help your young musician make time for personal practice at home. This is a requirement, like homework for other classes. When we get together in our classroom, we are supposed to be putting the different parts together. For Sinfonia and Sonatina, students should practice 30 minutes at home to learn their parts and remember the lessons taught during the day. More time is expected for students in Concertino and Chamber orchestra.
